COMMENTARY: Clicking on English Reports, Full Reprint, will direct us to the Case Locator. There are three ways of finding a specific case with the Case Locator that are shown on the following slides.

Method 1: Search by Case Name

[683] ATTORNEY-GENERAL v. HOLLAND. Dec. 11th, 21st, 1837.—Testator devised an estate to trustees and their successors, upon trust that all such decayed gentlemen as could make it appear to the trustees that they were of the testator's name and family, and of the age of 40 years, or else so impotent as not otherwise able to get a living, should be allowed out of the yearly rents and profits of the lands 10l. each by the year for their lives, so far as the rents would extend. At the time of making the will the annual rental of the estate was about 50l., but at the time of filing the information it amounted to about 500l. : Held, that this was a proper case for a scheme for the future management of the charity ; and that in preparing such a scheme the Master was to consider of the expediency of increasing the allowance and diminishing the number of the future objects of the charity, and also to define more accurately what class of persons (excluding all

COMMENTARY: In short, the Case Locator tool is not punctuation sensitive when you are searching by case name, an English Reports citation, or a nominative citation.

COMMENTARY: As shown in the screenshot above, we have the option to search the English Reports using keywords. That said, a more efficient way of searching for a specific case when you are missing information about it is to use the Advanced Search interface.

COMMENTARY: In our example, we will try searching by keyword, document type, and title. You will notice that we are using the search command, w/s which stands for within the same sentence. This is because the client in this scenario has indicated that they remember that the opening line of the case was about a testator who devised an estate to trustees. That between the years of 1814 and 1823 Edward Hunnings, one of the then trustees of the said charity, with the consent or through the negligence of the said George Holland, who was then a **trustee** of the said charity, applied a sum of 1561. 17s. 9d. part of the funds of the said charity to his own use; and his Majesty's Attorney-General has not been enabled to ascertain in what way the remainder of such rents and profits have been applied and disposed of. ...They admitted that they were the existing trustees of the charity, and that George Holland had become a **trustee** in 1815, Simpson in 1823, Cook in 1824, and John Holland, jun., in 1832. They stated that, upon the death or retirement of a **trustee**, it had been the invariable custom for the surviving or continuing trustees to appoint a new **trustee** in the room of the **trustee** so dying or retiring, and to enter such appointment in the books of the charity; and that they, 2 Y. & C.

COMMENTARY: A.-G v. Holland happened to be the second case in our list of search results. This example helps to illustrate that even though we were working with incomplete information, we were still able to find the case using Advanced Search.
